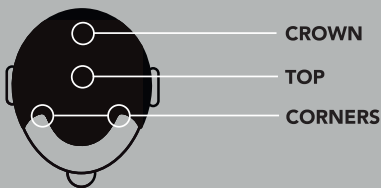


Everything You Need to Get Started

How to apply and use the medication It's a simple 3 step process - Spray. Massage. Dry.

1. Once a day, remove the spray nozzle cap, and apply 1 spray to each front corner and then apply 2 sprays to both the crown and top areas of your scalp, for a total of 6 sprays. It is best to lean your head slightly backwards to avoid any medication dripping onto your forehead. Don't forget to put the spray nozzle cap back in place.
2. Massage the medication in the area you sprayed for about 15 seconds.
3. Let the medicine dry before lying down, putting on a hat, or covering your head.

Wash your hands with soap and water after each application.



Other important information

- You may experience increased shedding of hair in the first 4-8 weeks of use. Do not be alarmed. This will subside and reverse itself.
- Using the medication more frequent than once a day or in higher quantities than prescribed will not speed up or increase hair growth.
- It will take at least 4-6 months for you to begin to see results of hair growth and results will vary.
- This medication must be used daily and on a continuous basis to maintain hair regrowth. Stopping the medication will result in hair loss.
- Keep the medication stored at room temperature (68°F to 77°F)

Storage & Disposal

Keep in a safe place, and away from children and pets. Do not throw away unused or expired drugs. Do not flush down the toilet or pour down the drain. Check with your pharmacist if you have questions on the best way to throw away your medication. There may be take-back programs in your area.

Uses

These medications are used in the treatment of hair loss, specifically for androgenic alopecia, also known as male or female-patterned baldness.

Compounding Information

This medication is a custom formulation recommended for you by your doctor and consists of a combination of two medications for the treatment of hair loss. Topical Minoxidil and oral Finasteride are FDA approved medications. The topical version of Finasteride is not FDA approved but is used off-label to help avoid the unwanted sexual side effects of the pill version.

Active Ingredients

Minoxidil - Regrows hair by stimulating resting hair follicles.

Finasteride - Stops hair loss by blocking the formation of dihydrotestosterone (DHT), which causes hair loss.

Side Effects

Common side effects include scalp irritation, redness, burning, itching, and increased sensitivity to the sun. These side effects usually go away over time. If they persist or are severe, please stop using the medication and contact us. Breast enlargement or tenderness - while this is rare, if it does happen, stop the medication immediately and alert your doctor.

Warnings

Allergic Reactions - do not use this medication if you are hypersensitive or allergic to either drug. If hives or swelling of the face, lips, tongue, or throat occur with use, discontinue the medication immediately and seek emergent medical care.

Precautions

• **Pregnancy** - this medication is not indicated for use in premenopausal women. Pregnant, potentially pregnant, or breast-feeding women should not come in contact with this medication.

- **Children** - this medication is not indicated for use for anyone under the age of 18.
- **PSA Testing** - lab testing for prostate specific antigen can be affected when using this medication. Please alert your doctor.
- **Flammable** - keep this medication away from electrical equipment, such as hair dryers or hair straighteners.
- **For scalp use only** - please do not apply this medication to any other part of your body. In case of accidental contact with your face, eyes, mouth, or nose, rinse thoroughly with cool water.
- **Do not use this medication** after its expiration date noted on the bottle.
- **Patients may experience changes in hair color or texture.**
